Candidate's Statement and Photo for the Educator due 1/15/18
9 South Spring Street, Concord, NH 03301, or rtrombly@nhnea.org.
- Candidates for NEA-NH offices who want a membership list or mailing labels must request these materials by Jan. 15, 2018. Requests should be sent to the Elections Committee at the address above.
- Candidate's names will appear on the ballot as they appear on the filing.

"In writing" means that the Elections Committee must physically receive such notification by letter or e-mail by the close of business (5:00 p.m.) on Jan. 15, 2018.

Executive Board Report: –Chuck S. suggested to bring in Brenden Brown to speak to the Council in January. There was discussion regarding how children are sent to other schools for different reasons and how School Boards get to make that determination. Commissioner of Education Frank Edelblute is trying to rewrite the rules. Sue Harden of the GR committee spoke regarding the need to elect candidates in locals for any position. Much discussion ensued. Senate Bill 193 was postponed and will not come up for vote until January. Brendon Brown will be sending out emails.

Membership: discussion by Carolyn re: Professional Development- the workshops NEA NH can offer for online needs to be updated. The membership survey that was sent out showed the same 3 categories popular amongst both ESP and teachers. The survey was an effort to delve deeper into the needs of the members in each region based on their answers on the 2017 yellow contact sheets. Each region will look a little different. It will be possible to delve even deeper by district, region and possibly buildings. Encourage members to take the survey so NEA NH can give members what they want/need for professional success.

Uniserv Director's Report: Lorri Hayes was unable to attend this month, so Linda Rollins gave report☺ NEA NH Delegate assembly will be held on 3/16/2018 at Colby Sawyer College. Lorri will attend December meeting. MOM (Mobilized messaging): If you need help, contact George Strout. There will be an ESP Webinar 11/15 @ 7PM (Children Dealing with the Absence of Parents). Chuck spoke about how many of the webinars are regionally applicable. Membership report-December will be more accurate with the numbers. Contact Janice Fitzpatrick, Director of Finance. Speak to her regarding reconciliation of member dues money due. Local is liable. Carolyn encouraged members to compare NEA/NH list with bill to compare against list from your local. Currently there are 2422 members in the Southern Region.

Council Attendance: How do we get more people to attend? How do we get NEW members to attend? Invitations-Topics-Raffle-Chuck S. talked about membership chair being placed into the raffle for December. Discussion ensued.

Executive Board Report: The NEA NH Executive Board discussed plans to send money to the International Affiliation to send to hurricane in PR where the money goes directly to NEA members. The Executive Board voted to send money to our state affiliates in Texas and Florida. How can we help individual states, including PR. Chuck Stohl discussed the possibility of having a spring council meeting

in Concord. A bench dedicated to Scott McGilvray has been placed outside the office in Concord. Carolyn discussed how fair share affects membership. Jill Owens discussed such things as ESP webinars and blizzard bags for locals. ESP NATIONAL WEBSITE, NEA has published a book for ESP's regarding proficiency of support staff. Linda Rollins was asked to send info to all locals. Mike Reilly will be invited to December/January meeting. Chuck reiterated bringing in locals to council meetings. The cards from Lorri Hayes are for sending to locals to get them involved. Council member's volunteered to reach out to the different locals.

Trainings & Workshops: Chuck discussed NEA's trainings that can be personalized to one's locals. Irv Richardson, director of PESS and Esther Dickinson can do legal workshops. Membership trainings are not only for new members but also for veteran members as well. Carolyn stated if you let NEA NH know what is needed, they will work to develop it.

Carol Scopa shared renter's affordable insurance (with California Casualty) through member benefits compared to other companies. UD Report:

- Lorri referred to the packet and results from survey of ESP and Teacher locals benefits; please review and let Lorri or Linda Rollins know if there are any discrepancies; good tool during your negotiations; good to use during negotiations

Megan Tuttle – President of NEA NH(November/December Executive Board Report):

- Esther Dickinson came to board meeting to discuss Janus – Megan explained Janus – this is relevant to the loss of fair share/agency fee; it is at the Supreme Court; decision in early June of 2018; NH doesn't have a statewide fair share (50 locals); the effect on NEA National will be huge – loss of money to state funding; an Agency Fee team is set up on the state level to help those locals through
- Move our membership dinners to March: the reason is membership is year round but NEA NH is making an effort to connect more things and think more linear. The goal is to give locals the tools to get members to join the early bird special, and how to talk to members and get members to stay or join. This is an effort to band together and stay strong!

- March is busy, but NEA NH feels like that this really is the time for this push.
- Delegate Assembly is March 16, 2018 at Colby Sawyer College.
- Fiduciary training by to go over the role of a board member and how to be a responsible board member.
- Administrators approached NEA NH about affiliating with us. Megan had researched if this is a practice in other states. The NEA NH Executive Board voted to not entertain this idea at this time.
- 1% EZ Pay Discount: NEA NH is working on the best way to distribute the discount
- Proposed By law changes will be brought forth at the Delegate Assembly. Biggest item at this time: Terms for Executive Board to start July 1 and who votes for the ESP at large position. Proposed by law change: ESP would vote for ESP seat. .
- Senate Bill 193: Vouchers
 - Takes money out of public schools and sends money to private and religious schools. There is no accountability of the money that goes to those families. This will be devastating to towns! Property taxes will go through the roof and this will affect contracts being passed. The vote could be January 3, 2018. NEA NH is asking members to fill out 2 postcards each to ask your legislators to vote this down.
- New Coalition: to get education friendly people elected in our locals on school boards and town officials – called "Build a Bench Group".

Jeff Kantorowski (Coordinator of Benefit Programs):

- Presented programs and services about NEA Member Benefits and had a question/answer session

Caitlin Rollo (Coordinator of Organizing):

- Spring 2017 Contact Survey Results
- Follow – up survey specific to each region. Membership Committee has been delving into this regional information and will follow up with each region.
- Fall 2017 New Educator Organizing Campaign Data – increased our 1:1 conversations with new members over last year
- Early Enrollment Campaign will be rolled out at Membership Dinners.

Linda Rollins, UniServ Assistant:

- New prorated chart is now out
- Pro-rated dues is for brand new member – never been an NEA member or people returning from a leave
- Be sure your roster is accurate up to date! Match ever member on the bill from NEA NH to the roster from your SAU list. Don't forget to include your credit card members!
- There was quite a bit of discussion about when the prorated dues are being used.
- Carolyn will reach out to NEA NH leadership for clarification
- Local dues amounts should be sent into Linda

Other:
